## BUCKYNET FOR EMPLOYERS

---

### WHAT IS BUCKYNET?

BuckyNet is our online recruiting system powered by Symplicity. BuckyNet delivers interactive recruitment resources for employers, including searchable online résumé books and the ability to request on-campus interviews, post jobs and internships, view resume books, and register for information sessions, career fairs, and other events. As an employer, you are able to access one database to reach candidates and post positions that cross many schools/colleges of UW-Madison. Account registration is free of charge to access all BuckyNet services.

### HOW DO I SIGN UP?

Follow the steps below!

- Go to the L&S Career Services homepage and click on Employers.
- Then click on the BuckyNet link.
- Go to the “Create Your Account” tab and then follow the directions.
- After your registration is approved by L&S Career Services, you will be able to login and use BuckyNet on a regular basis!

## BUCKYNET FOR STUDENTS

---

### WHAT IS BUCKYNET?

BuckyNet is our password-protected interactive online system which connects students and employers. Through BuckyNet, you can search and apply for internships and full-time opportunities, post your resume, sign-up for on-campus interviews and mock interviews, research employers, and see schedules of our career fairs, employer information sessions and career events. Employers in the corporate, government and nonprofit sectors post on BuckyNet on a daily basis, with many career fields of interest to you!

### HOW DO I SIGN UP?

Follow the steps below!

- Go to the L&S Career Services homepage and click “Students & Alumni”.
- Click on the “BuckyNet” tab on the left-hand side and complete the registration screen.
- After your registration is approved by L&S Career Services, a password will be emailed to your email address.
- Login to BuckyNet using your username (full email address) and password (unique).
- You will also be able to download the Careers by Symplicity mobile app to use as well.

## BUCKYNET FAQ'S FOR STUDENTS

---

### What can I do on BuckyNet?

- Upload documents (Resume, Cover Letter, etc.)
- Research employers and career fields
- Apply for jobs and internships - up to 50 positions a day are posted!
- Sign up for campus interviews, information sessions, workshops, and career fairs

### How do I access BuckyNet?

Several schools and colleges on campus have portals to BuckyNet. It is important that you register through the correct one:

- Letters & Science
- Agricultural & Life Sciences
- Business
- Education
- Pharmacy

### Why should I be on BuckyNet?

It is highly recommended because some event registrations require a BuckyNet account:

- Career Fairs
- On Campus Recruiting
- Mock Interviews
- Information Sessions and Workshops

### Do I have to pay to make a BuckyNet account?

No, it's free!

### Where are the jobs posted on BuckyNet located?

BuckyNet is a place where you can find anything from local to international opportunities. You are able to customize your search to fit your interests and the location of your job.
